## B. Football Camp Forms

## C. Section Update

1. Reviewed that the Soccer season of sport would be Winter for both boys and girls starting in the 2016-17 school year. Each school should take this next year to prepare for coaching staff conflicts, practice/game site conflicts, rain games, etc.
2. Briefly reviewed the new Playoff Rules for 2015-16
  - a. League champion must play at the level of league designation in football, girls volleyball, boys and girls basketball, boys and girls soccer and softball. All other member schools will play at their size designation.
  - b. Cross Country will change the alignments in Divisions I-IV to equal out the numbers.
  - c. Additional qualifiers in football for each of the 7 leagues that have had the most success over the last 3 years.
  - d. For team tennis (boys& girls) the SFL and Delta will receive an additional qualifier
  - e. Water Polo will add a 3<sup>rd</sup> division.
  - f. There will be north and south girls regional wrestling tournaments
